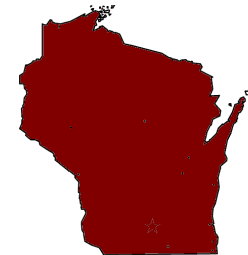

Steps to Summer Ministry

- Prayerfully consider how the Lord would have you spend your summer.

All the following activities are required

- Attend Orientation Part 1
April 23, 2011
CEF Madison Office

At this session you will receive the materials needed for preparation and teaching. You will also be guided as you complete your support letter and prepare it for mailing. The policy of CEF is *Ask God and tell His people*. It is the responsibility of each missionary to raise funds for the Summer Ministry Fund and your training fees. One of the most effective ways for telling His people is a letter sharing what you are planning to do this summer.

- Attend Orientation Part 2
May 14, 2011

Learn what to expect at training, hand in materials you will have been given at session 1, get the 'heads up' on what summer and teaching will be like, and meet other missionaries.

- CYIA training
June 12-24, 2011

Training is 12 days at Camp Fairwood, near Coloma.

Who: *young adults aged 14* and older
*born-again believer (at least two years)
*have a sincere desire to serve the Lord
*agree with CEF Doctrinal Policy & Statement of Faith

When: Training is June 12 – 24, 2011
Weeks you teach are according to your availability and your local chapter's schedule

Where: Camp Fairwood, Westfield, WI

Cost: \$475 (\$10 due by March 31, 2011 (remainder due prior to training)
Summer Missionaries raise personal financial support through letters they send out. This is used for the cost of training, salary for the 5-Day Clubs taught and to assist with administrative costs.

Why: Because children everywhere need Jesus!

How: Teach 5-Day Clubs® in neighborhoods, backyards, community centers, etc. 5-Day Clubs® are held for one hour per day for one week during the summer. Summer Missionaries may teach one, two or three clubs per day, per week depending on the schedule.

Three weeks of teaching, after completion of training, is the minimum requirement.

*Younger teens need local CEF director's approval to attend training.



* Learn how to lead children to Christ with proven methods of evangelism taught by certified instructors.

* Use dynamic Bible lessons and an inspiring missionary story.

* Learn creative teaching techniques.

* Learn memory verses and songs that will be used to help children understand the message of salvation.

* Enjoy a time of personal spiritual growth as you study, practice, teach, and join other young adults in worship, class time and fellowship.

Training is intensive; therefore, a genuine desire to learn and serve the Lord is necessary!
