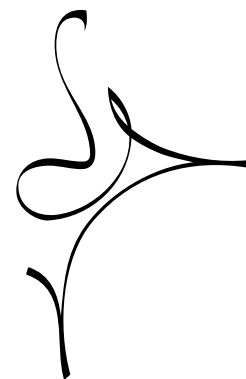
From Summer Missionary Alicia Jones:

In addition to regular course work, three practicum sessions conducted during the course provide each student with evaluated experience in applying the theory taught. Students are also required to participate in teaching five children's classes within 90 days of completion of the course to receive a certificate.

Ministry at the Fairs 2009

This summer CEF had the privilege of sharing the Gospel with 740 children, teens, and adults at the Stoughton Fair and the Rock County Fair. There were 222 who made a first-time profession of faith. At the Stoughton Fair 14 Summer Missionaries and 17 adult CEF volunteers worked in two 4-hour shifts Wed. July 1, through Sun. July 5. Rock County Fair went from Tues. July 28 through Sun. Aug. 2. There were 9 CEF adults and 12 Summer Missionaries working in three 4-hour shifts.
